CREED

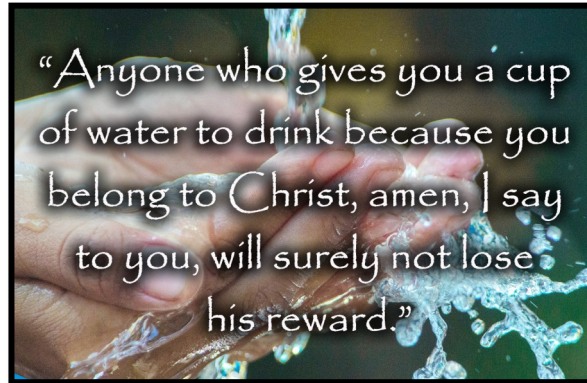
